



# NOTTINGHAM CITY CENTRE PUB GUIDE



A great many pubs in Nottingham offer **CAMRA Discount** - listed here in **BLUE** - so do ask at the bar. Or check the latest issue of the Nottingham Drinker.

**DO CHECK OPENING TIMES VIA WHATPUB.COM**

**1. VAT & FIDDLE** *Queens Bridge Road NG2 1NB.* 200 yards from the railway station. Castle Rock Brewery Tap with 12 handpulls. Full range of Castle Rock plus occasional guests.

**2. FELLOWS, MORTON & CLAYTON** (FMC) *Canal Street NG1 7EH.* 8 beers: Tim Taylors Landlord and a St Austell beer are regulars; usually something from Lincoln Green & Nottingham breweries.

**3. THE CANALHOUSE** *Canal Street NG1 7EH.* Castle Rock pub with generally 3 Castle Rock beers + up to 3 guests on. The Canalhouse is unique in that there is a canal boat parked inside the pub (one of the ways to the bar is across a bridge over the canal).

**4. THE CASK ROOM @ VIA FOSSA** *Canal Street Nottingham NG1 7EH.* Bright, open beer hall with vaulting ceilings and cosy hideaways. Six real ales from local breweries.

**5. NEWSHOUSE** *Canal Street NG1 7HB.* 2 room Castle Rock pub. 2 Castle Rock beers + 2 guests which usually includes a mild.

**6. NAVIGATION** *Wilford Street NG2 1AA.* Marstons house, has up to 12 beers from the Marstons stable, such as Jennings, Wychwood, etc.

**7. YE OLD TRIP TO JERUSALEM** *Brewhouse Yard, NG1 6AD.* At the foot of Nottingham Castle, built into the rock face. One of the oldest pubs in Nottingham. Owned by Greene King; has Nottingham beers + other Locals / Regionals as guests.

**8. FOTHERGILLS** *Castle Road NG1 6AA.* Small bar/restaurant with 4 changing guest ales.

**9. THE SALUTATION** *Hounds Gate NG1 7AA.* Another old pub, claims to be older than the Trip. Up to 8 changing ales. A rock music pub.

**10. NED LUDD** *27 Friar Lane NG1 6DA.* Small modern bar with up to 4 ales available, 2 from Navigation Brewery + 2 guests.

**11. APPROACH** *Friar Lane NG1 6DQ.* A modern city centre pub, normally offering a couple of Navigation Brewery beers. Usually has some form of live music during the evening, gets very busy during the weekend.

**12. THE JOSEPH ELSE** *South Parade, Market Square NG1 2IS.* Wetherspoon pub offering up to 14 beers, next to the tram stop.

**13. BELL INN** *Angel Row NG1 6HL.* Arguably the oldest pub in Nottingham, with 3 separate rooms; owned by Greene King with a full range of their beers, plus guests from Nottingham Brewery. **Note:** *The house beer is from Greene King.*

**14. DRAGON** *67 Long Row West NG1 6JE.* Long narrow pub with the bar at the back, 4 beers available, Roosters is a regular.

**15. ROEBUCK** *St James Street NG1 6FH.* Wetherspoon pub with 15 handpumps serving a mixture of local, regional and national brands.

**16. MALT CROSS** *St James Street NG1 6FG.* Built in 1877 and one of only a few Victorian Music Halls remaining. Look for the impressive high-arched glazed

roof. 5 changing beers; house beer from Brewsters; 'Charles Henry Strange' is Navigation APUS re-badged.

**17. BARREL DROP** *7 Hurts Yard NG1 6JD* On alley off Angel Row. Micropub with up to 10 guest beers on stillage + real cider.

**18. HORN IN HAND** *Goldsmith Street NG1 5JT.* Single bar, popular with a younger clientele and up to 3 beers available, generally from smaller micro-breweries.

**19. LANGTRYS** *4 South Sherwood Street NG1 4BY.* Popular city centre pub, features 8 beers from near and far, also large selection of regional real ciders and perries.

**20. THREE CROWNS** *51 Upper Parliament Street NG1 6LD* Six cask ales from National & Regional brewers. Good value food served.

**21. MAJOR OAK** *Pelham Street NG1 2EG.* Greene King 'O.S.H.' as regular. Up to 7 ever-changing guests from micros; lots of screens showing sport, usually with no sound. Good value food menu.

**22. LLOYDS No1** *1 Carlton Street NG1 1NL.* Conversion of an old bank building, between 8 & 12 beers, very good value, even for a Wetherspoon pub.

**23. BROADWAY** *14 Broad Street NG1 3AL.* Public bar of an independent cinema; 3 beers with the house beer brewed by Nottingham Brewery.

**24. CROSS KEYS** *Byard Lane NG1 2GJ.* Freehouse run by Great Northern Inns with beers from Navigation Brewery, both their

regular and seasonal offerings. You may find a couple of guests as well.

**25. KEANS HEAD** *St Mary's Gate NG1 1QA.* Small single-bar Castle Rock pub in the Lace Market; up to 6 beers, Castle Rock and guests.

**26. ANNIES BURGER SHACK / OCEAN STATE TAVERN 5** *Broadway, Lace Market NG1 1PR.*

The upstairs portion is more dedicated to dining but still has 10 handpumps, while the downstairs bar is for the drinkers and has a repeat of 5 beers on upstairs.

**27. CRAFTY CROW** *Friar Lane NG1 6EB.* Magpie Brewery own this freehouse; 10 handpumps, 2 from Magpie & the rest are micros from around the country. Lots of use of recycled material. Every drink in the establishment comes from smaller producers.

**28. THE ROUNDHOUSE** *Royal Standard Place NG1 6FS.* This building was part of the old Nottingham General Hospital; a freehouse with 6 beers on offer and the house beer Roundheart, is brewed by Dancing Duck.

**29. CAST** *Nottingham Playhouse, Wellington Circus NG1 5AL.* Bar to the Playhouse, up to 3 beers normally available mainly for local micros.

**30. HAND & HEART** *65-67 Derby Road NG1 5BA.* Freehouse & sister pub to the Roundhouse, also has Roundheart as the house beer, plus 7 ever changing guests.

**31. RAGLAN ROAD** *69-73 Derby Road NG1 5BA.* Next door to the H&H (above). Castle Rock

Harvest Pale as a regular plus 3 guests from National & Regional breweries. An Irish themed sports bar.

**32. ROPEWALK** *107-111 Derby Road NG1 5BB.* 4 changing beers from micro breweries, popular with students, but all made welcome.

**33. SIR JOHN BORLASE WARREN** *Ilkeston Road NG7 3GD.* Everards Project William pub, run by Brown Ales; has 2 of their beers, Everards Tiger plus 7 guests.

**34. FALCON** *1 Alfreton Road NG7 3JE.* Small single bar corner pub. Has 6 pumps: 2 or 3 from Lincoln Green Brewery, a St Austell beer and the rest from micros.

**35. ORGAN GRINDER** *Alfreton Road NG7 3JE.* Blue Monkey Brewery Tap. 9 beers, Blue Monkey plus Doom Bar.

**36. PORTLAND ARMS** *Portland Street NG7 4GN.* A Greene King pub, but generally has 2 beers from Full Mash of Stapleford.

**37. BUNKERS HILL** *Hockley NG1 1FP.* A Pub People Co pub; up to 6 beers available, usually a mixture of regional brewers and local micros. Next door to the National Ice Arena.

**38. KING WILLIAM IV** *Eyre Street NG2 4PB.* Genuine family-run freehouse with 7 handpumps serving Oakham JHB & Bishops Farewell; the other 5 are regular rotating guests from various micros. NB: Selection of cobs highly recommended!

**39. FORESTERS INN** *187 Huntingdon Street NG1 3NL.* Street-corner local. 3 beers from

local micros, good value for money.

**40. ROSE OF ENGLAND** *36-38 Mansfield Road NG1 3JA.* Imposing Watson Fothergill-designed building. It is mainly tied to national beers but can have interesting guests from local & micro brewers.

**41. PEACOCK HOTEL** *11 Mansfield Road NG1 3FB.* Impressive 2 room pub, the lounge still has push-bell service at quiet times. Beers mainly from Caledonian & Theakstons, with occasional interesting guests.

**42. GOOSEBERRY BUSH** *Peel Street NG1 4GL.* Wetherspoon pub on the site of the old maternity hospital; 10 beers available and popular with students from the adjoining campus.

**43. LINCOLNSHIRE POACHER** *161-163 Mansfield Road NG1 3FR.* Multi-area Castle Rock pub with 13 changing beers available: Castle Rock and micros from around the country. Large bottled beer range.

**44. FOREST TAVERN** *257 Mansfield Road NG1 3FT.* Castle Rock establishment which has a music venue, The Maze at the back. 4 Castle Rock beers on.
