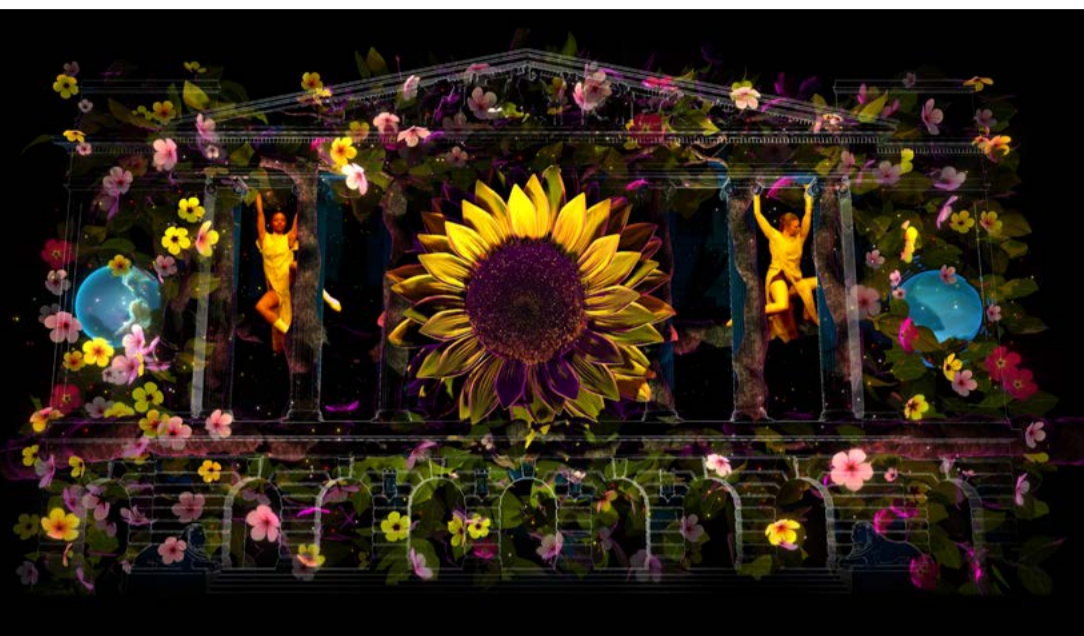
Prepare to be dazzled as this year's Light Night promises an unforgettable evening filled with light based installations and awe-inspiring experiences.
